Examination & Certification

- Y The Practitioner Re-registration examination is a one-hour (open book) objective test consisting of three questions. The pass mark is 60%.
- Y The PRINCE2 Examination Board has determined that all PRINCE2 Practitioners should be re-registered within 3-5 years of their original certification. This re-registration comprises an examination set at the same standard as the current Practitioner examination.
- Y All Practitioners who have taken the PRINCE2 Practitioner qualification since October 2000 have agreed or are agreeing to this requirement as part of their initial application and so are now designated as Registered Practitioners.
- Y Practitioners certified prior to October 2000 have the opportunity to take the re-registration examination in order to demonstrate their commitment to professional development. This is particularly important following 2 updates to the method, occurring in 2005 and June 2009, in which the method has materially changed.
- Y Those who have qualified since January 2001 or have voluntarily undertaken the re-registration qualification are designated as Registered Practitioners, which enables Employers and prospective Employers to be confident with their current knowledge and commitment to Continuing Professional Development. Successful delegates receive the PRINCE2™ 2009™ Practitioner certificate issued by APMG
