

PRINCE2® 2009 Conversion

Course Description

The event aims to develop a greater understanding of PRINCE2 2009 providing an exam-focussed revision of the PRINCE2 2009 method. It provides guidance and practice in the approach to achieve examination success.

The Practitioner event is focussed on the implementation and practical application of the method.

Previous PRINCE2 Foundation examination success is a pre-requisite for attending this event.

Please note that a conversion course detailing the differences between PRINCE2 2005 and PRINCE2 2009 is strongly recommended if your Foundation Certificate was gained before the new Foundation method examination was available on the 8th July 2009.

- Y Understand how to apply the PRINCE2 2009 method
- Y Prepare for and take the PRINCE2 Practitioner Certificate examinations

Course Outline

The course is accredited by the APM Group. Training is practical and consists of classroom lectures, discussions, examination preparation and techniques with the opportunity of mock examination question practice. This provides delegates with a sound knowledge of PRINCE2 2009 and prepares them for the Practitioner examination.

Core topics studied during the course are:

- Y Evaluate Examination practice
- Y Examination techniques explained
- Y Coaching on common examination faults
- Y Explanation of Examination schedule

Examination & Certification

The Practitioner examination is a two and a half-hour (open book), objective test examination consisting of nine questions. The pass mark is 55%. Successful delegates receive the PRINCE2 Practitioner certificate is issued by APMG
